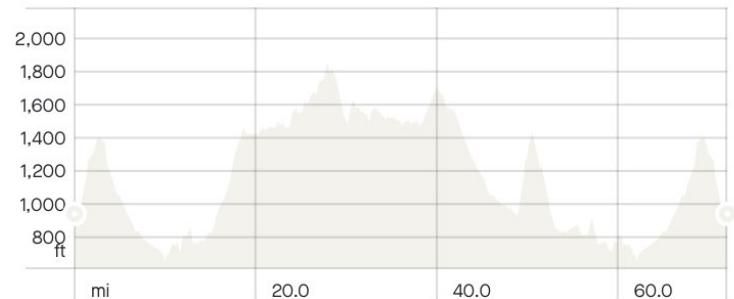
## Long Course

## Elevation



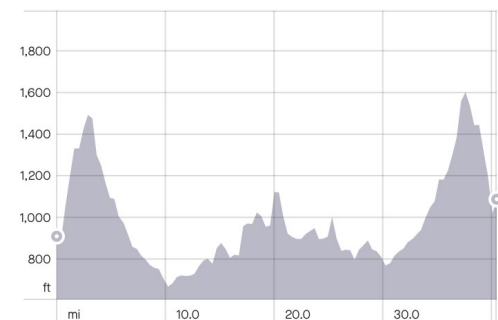

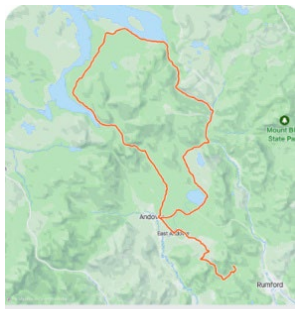
## Elevation

Rumford Gravel, brought to you by Downeast Racing, Black Mountain of Maine and LL Bean, is an adventure ride through the deep woods and past some of the many sparkling lakes of Maine. There are some steep up and down sections that will test one, but the roads are good. Riding mph averages will range from 17mph to 10mph so pick a course length based on how long you want to be in the saddle. The long course has 2 aid stations (mile 23 & 52) and the short course 1 aid station (mile 21).

40mm tire selection is recommended

Gearing recommendation: 48/34 front, 10/45 rear

Overnight camping is available on site at Black Mountain of Maine.

Food and drink available at Black Mountain of Maine dining room.

Merchandise prize first 3 men/women/short/long courses + many others via bib number drawing – keep your bib!
